

## “This Same Jesus Shall So Come”

Acts 1:9-11

June 25, 2006

All of the Bible writers were moved infallibly by the Holy Spirit to give us t\_\_\_\_ Word of G\_\_\_\_. (2Ti.3:16; 2Pe.1:20-21)

The Gospel of Luke and the book of Acts were written by Luke to Theophilus (l\_\_\_\_\_ of God). (1Co.2:14)

Each of the four gospel accounts h\_\_\_\_\_ to be written. Why four? (Joh.5:39; Exo.25:40; 27:16; Eze.1:10; 2Co.3:18; Rev.4:7):

**Matthew**, *Jesus, the K\_\_\_\_\_*, **Purple (royalty)** L\_\_\_\_\_

**Mark**, *Jesus, the S\_\_\_\_\_*, **Scarlet (sacrifice)** O\_\_\_\_\_

**Luke**, *Jesus, the Perfect M\_\_\_\_\_*, **White (purity)** M\_\_\_\_\_

**John**, *Jesus, G\_\_\_\_\_*, **Blue (heavenly origin)** E\_\_\_\_\_

The Lord in at least t\_\_\_\_ appearances gave these witnesses infallible proofs that He is indeed bodily risen from the dead (Act.1:3): they h\_\_\_\_\_ Him with their ears (Joh.20:19); they s\_\_\_\_\_ Him with their eyes (Joh.20:20); they f\_\_\_\_\_ His breath (Joh.20:22). He f\_\_\_\_\_ a meal and gave it to them (Joh.21:10-14). They t\_\_\_\_\_ Him and held Him by His feet (Mat.28:9), and He a\_\_\_\_\_ food before them (Luk.24:41-43). (1Jo.1:1-4)

The Lord did His teaching through the Holy Spirit. How much more do we need to d\_\_\_\_\_ upon Him in order to teach? (Act.1:2; Joh.15:5; 16:7-14)

The Lord commanded them to wait for the p\_\_\_\_\_ of the Father. When the Holy Spirit came He would bring

the redeemed into a new relationship and fellowship with G\_\_\_\_. (Gal.4:1-7; 2Pe.1:3-4; Eph.1:3)

It is o\_\_\_\_\_ through the Holy Spirit that we can carry out the Lord’s plan of worldwide evangelism. (Act.1:8)

Our Lord was not taken up from His own until He had said His l\_\_\_\_\_ words to these Whom He loved. (Act.1:9; Joh.13:1) What would you like your last words to be?

Last words are very important. We must never lose sight of our calling to e\_\_\_\_\_, b\_\_\_\_\_ and t\_\_\_\_\_ to observe all things here and throughout the world. How are we doing this? (Act.1:8-9; Mat.28:19-20)

The One Who is the L\_\_\_\_\_ of the world, the fullness of the godhead bodily, the express image of His person, the brightness of His glory, is now taken up from them into the cloud of the Lord. He shall come again in c\_\_\_\_\_ of glory (Act.1:9,11; Rev.1:7; 1Th.4:16-17)

Not even the presence of two a\_\_\_\_\_ could deter their fixed vision upon the Lord’s ascension. (Act.1:10; Gen.18-19; Joh.20:11-16)

Jesus ascended b\_\_\_\_\_, v\_\_\_\_\_ and p\_\_\_\_\_. And “this same Jesus ... shall so come in like manner...” What should this truth do for believers? (Act.1:9-11; 1Th.4:13-18; Rev.1:7; Joh.14:3; 2Th.1:7-11; 1Jo.3:1-3)

What did the disciples do next? What should you be doing? (Act.1:12; Rom.12:1-2; Mat.28:19-20)
