

## Suffer the Children to Come Unto Me

Matthew 19:13-15

June 4, 2006

Children are sinners by i\_\_\_\_ sin. We all became a sinner in A\_\_\_\_. (Rom.5:12)

Children are sinners by an i\_\_\_\_ sin nature. (Psa.51:5)

Children are sinners by c\_\_\_\_. (Isa.53:6; Psa.53:2-3; Psa.58:3)

Children are d\_\_\_\_\_ in their sins. (Eph.2:1; Luk.7:11-15)

Children are n\_\_\_\_\_ able to come to the Savior in and of themselves. (Joh.6:44)

You may be able and must train a child to do what it is right. Your training cannot impart spiritual l\_\_\_\_\_ unto them. (Pro.22:6; Rom.11:6; Joh.3:8)

You cannot o\_\_\_\_\_ God to save you or your children by things that you do! That isn't grace, but w\_\_\_\_\_. (Rom.4:1-6; 11:6; Eph.2:8-9; Tit.3:5)

It's not through any kind of religious p\_\_\_\_\_ that children are saved. What are some of these that people trust in for salvation?

It is God a\_\_\_\_\_ that can bring any sinner (child or adult) to Christ for salvation. (Eph.1:5; Joh.3:8; 6:44; Jer.31:3)

We are not to f\_\_\_\_\_ or h\_\_\_\_\_ our children in any way from coming to Christ. (Mat.19:13-15)

We can hinder them from coming to Christ by...

- a) being a wrong e\_\_\_\_\_ (Gen.13:10-13)
- b) allowing wrong i\_\_\_\_\_ (Gen.13:10-13)
- c) having them under wrong d\_\_\_\_\_ (1Ti.4:16)

We must bring them up in the fear of the Lord, making them to know that G\_\_\_\_ takes care of them, not m\_\_\_\_\_, or the U.S. government, or even their parents. (Pro.1:7; Act.17:25)

The Lord is their Creator and Sustainer. Jesus Christ is the only Savior. Eternal life is in knowing and walking with the L\_\_\_\_\_ J\_\_\_\_\_ C\_\_\_\_\_. (Joh.17:3; 8:12)

We must bring them to Jesus continually by...

- a) teaching them the B\_\_\_\_\_ (Joh.5:39; 2Ti.3:14-16)
- b) taking them to a Christ-centered c\_\_\_\_\_ (Rev.1:10f; Mat.18:20; Act.2:42-47)
- c) giving them spiritual training in the h\_\_\_\_\_ (Pro.22:6; Eph.6:4)
- d) bringing them to the Lord continually in p\_\_\_\_\_ (Mat.7:7-8)

We should be hopeful for the salvation of our lost because Christ came to save s\_\_\_\_\_, and this message is each member of our f\_\_\_\_\_. (1Ti.1:15; Act.16:30-32)
