\* In the OT we have pictures of Christ and what He would accomplish for His people. In the O.T. redemption referred to...

1. The release of the fi\_stbo\_n sons and male animals from dedication to the Lord's service by their money payments and by God's giving the tribe of Levi in their place. (Exo.13:2,11-16; 21:8; Lev.25:47-49; 27:27; Num.3:46-49; 18:15f).
2. The release of one under the sentence of d\_a\_h by an agreed payment to the victim's family. (Exo.21:28-30)
3. The release on the basis of payment for one who had fallen into sl\_ve\_y. (Exo.21:8; Lev.25:47-49)
4. The restoration of an inheritance to an heir by the payment by the near-k\_nsm\_n (go-el). (Lev.25:26; Rut.4:4f)

\*All the above picture for us what is clearly revealed in the NT: the Lord Jesus, the \_nl\_ qualified Redeemer for His people, Who was and is fully God (Joh.1:1-3; etc.) and so had no debts of His own became fully man (Joh.1:14; etc.) to become the Go-el, to pay their debt, and so bring about their redemption – release!

## ***II. Present Redemption***

1. Christ has secured the redemption of “many” from their guilt by His a\_tu\_l ransom on the cross. (Mar.10:45; Isa.53:4-6,10-12; ; Rev.5:9)
  - 1) Through their union with Christ by f\_it\_ believers have release from the guilt of their sins. (Rom.5:1,8-9; Gal.3:13; Rom.8:1-3,33-34)
  - 2) Through their union by faith with Christ believers are redeemed from the slavery of the opinions, fads and ways of this w\_r\_d. (Eph.2:1-2; Gal.1:4; Rom.12:1-2)
  - 3) Through their union by faith in Christ believers have plenteous redemption and so release from the p\_w\_r of their sins.
    - a) Believers are no longer servants to sin. They do not h\_v\_ to serve sin. (Eph.2:1,3; 1Co.6:9-11,18-20)
    - b) The Lord Jesus on the cross redeemed believers from a\_\_ sin. (Tit.2:14)
    - c) Believers are to know, r\_ck\_n on, yield to, and obey what the Lord Jesus has accomplished for us in His death. (Rom.5:20-6:23)
    - d) Nor do believers have to serve the one who is the pr\_nc\_ of sin. (Eph.2:2; Col.1:13; Eph.6:10-11; Jam.4:7)
    - e) There is still a struggle for believers because they are in these fallen, sinful b\_d\_es that are yet to be redeemed. (Rom.7:14-24)

## ***III. Future Redemption***

1. The ransom has been paid, but believers are yet to \_xp\_ri\_nc\_ the redemption of their bodies.
    - 1) This redemption is the believer's h\_p\_. (Rom.7:25; 8:18-25)
    - 2) This hope of redemption s\_v\_s the believer from defeat and despondency, and strengthens him to keep going. (2Pe.3:10-14; Rom.8:24-25)
    - 3) The Holy Spirit has sealed believers \_nt\_l that day of redemption. (Eph.1:13-14)
- \* Jesus Christ paid the ransom for “many”. Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you shall be redeemed from the penalty, power, prince and one day - the presence of your sins.
