I. The Meaning of the Word – “Saved”

Strong’s Greek Dictionary, “to save, deliver or protect: heal, preserve, save, do well, be (make) whole.” (Strong’s # 4982)

II. The Message of the Word – “Saved”

1. By nature none of us wants to be saved. There is no desire for or fear of the tr_e God. (Rom.3:11,18)
2. To be saved is to be delivered from the p_n_lty of sin.
 - 1) We are a__ by nature sinners and children of wrath. (Rom.3:23; 6:23; Eph.2:3)
 - 2) Our Savior gave up His life-blood to deliver His people from the wrath due them. (Rom.5:9)
3. To be saved is to be delivered from the power and pl__sure of sin.
 - 1) In salvation the Holy Spirit gives us a h__rt to please God, and to be delivered from our sin. (Eze.36:24-25; Joh.3:3-8; Eph.4:17-24)
 - 2) God has given us His W__d to save (deliver) us from sin. (Joh.17:17; 1Ti.4:16; Psa.119:9-11)
4. To be saved is to be brought into the f_ll_wship and favor of the Lord. (Joh.10:9-10; 17:3; 1Co.1:9; 1Jo.1:3)
5. All the saved shall one day be saved from the very pr_s_nce of sin. (Rev.21:27)

III. The Man of the Word – “Saved”

1. This salvation is not in a religious pl_n, but in a man - “the Man, Jesus Christ the Lord”.
 - 1) His name tells us Who HE IS! Jesus means “Jehovah i_ salvation”. (Mat.1:21; Luk.2:11; Joh.4:42)
 - 2) Our Lord came to save sinners, not to c_nd_mn them. (Luk.19:10; Joh.3:17)
 - 3) The Lord is not only a savior, He is *the _ne and _nly* Savior. (Joh.10:9; 14:6; 1Ti.2:5; Act.4:12)
 - 4) Only those who come by f__th to this Savior shall be saved. All who come are saved. (Joh.3:36; 5:40; Act.2:21; Joh.6:37)

IV. The Mission in the Word – “Saved”

1. The Lord came to this world on a mission to save s_nn_rs. (Luk.19:10; Joh.4:32)
2. Seeking the salvation of sinners is now o_r mission. (Joh.4:33-35)
 - 1) This mission was given to us as a c_mm_nd by our Lord. (Mat.28:18-20)
 - 2) This mission should ever be on our h__rts. (Rom.9:1-3)
 - 3) This mission should be in our pr_y_rs. (Rom.10:1-3)
 - 4) Christians should _v_r be seeking the salvation of sinners. (Mat.28:19; 1Co.9:19-23)
