God in His grace purchased His el___t to Himself. (Eph.1:6-7; Rev.5:9; Rom.3:23-25)

4. Preceding Grace

God's grace came to us while we were d___d in our sins. (Eph.2:1,4,5,8; Joh.3:8)

5. Plucking Grace

1) God's grace plucked us out of the corruptions of our dep___ity. (Psa.40:2; Eph.2:1,3)

2) God's grace plucked us out of the course of the diso___dient. (Eph.2:2; Joh.15:18-20)

3) God's grace plucked us out of the captivity of the d____l. (Col.1:13; Eph.2:2)

6. Planting Grace

1) God's grace planted us in the ki___dom of His Dear Son. (Col.1:13; Rev.1:5-6)

2) God's grace planted us in the p___hs of righteousness. (Eph.2:10)

3) God's grace planted us in the f___ily of God with God as our Father, Jesus Christ as our Br___er, the Holy Spirit as our Com___rter, and God's children as our brethren. (Rom.8:15-39)

7. Peace-giving Grace

1) God's grace doesn't point us to what we have done, but to what God has done f___ us in Christ, and so we have such, great, blessed peace. (Rom.4:5,25; 5:1)

8. Preserving Grace

God's grace will k___p His elect to the end. (Jud.1; Joh.10:26-30; Phi.1:6)

9. Pedagoguing Grace

God's grace s___s to it that believers do what is pleasing in His sight. (Tit.2:11-14; Heb.12:5-14; 13:20-21)

10. Provisioning Grace

God's grace has given believers a ___ needed for life and godliness. (Eph.1:3-5; 2Pe.1:3)

11. Perfecting Grace

God's grace will bring all of the elect into the perfect image of His Son. (Rom.8:28-32)

12. Presenting Grace

A ___ of God's elect will be presented to God one day. (Eph.1:5-6; Joh.6:39)

13. Panoramic Grace

God's grace will ___ reach a multitude which no man can number in all classes and of all kindreds, languages, people-groups, and nations. (Rev.7:9; 5:9; Tit.2)

14. Proffered Grace

This all of grace salvation is in now to be preached unto all – to you! (Mat.28:19-20; Mar.16:15)
